13 **Resolved,** that a list of member benefits be included in the annual report to the House of  
14 Delegates.

18 **REPORT BACKGROUND**

19  
20 The council and board investigated the feasibility of developing a member benefit to address  
21 this issue. They determined that ASDA should provide its members with information on how to  
22 start a food bank and explore potential partnerships with retailers for discounts or  
23 memberships

24  
25 **REPORT FINDINGS**

26  
27 Based on the findings of the initial investigation, a resource was developed to assist chapters  
28 with starting a food bank at their dental school. This resource is available on ASDA's website.  
29 Additionally, ASDA is working to develop a partnership with Amazon Fresh and Uber Eats. ASDA  
30 is working to confirm those partnerships. Finally, a policy has been written regarding dental  
31 students experiencing poverty to be presented at the House of Delegates (see Appendix A).

33 A progress report was sent to the sponsors of the resolution prior to Fall Council 2025. A list of  
34 member benefits is included in the annual report which is accessible in the Annual Session  
35 mobile app.

Appendix A

**Title: Addressing Food Insecurity Among Dental Students**

**Background:** At the 2025 House of Delegates, resolution 305-2025 Support for Dental Students Experiencing Poverty was passed. In this resolution, the Council on Membership and the Board of Trustees were charged with investigating potential member benefits with food and grocery companies. The council and board also recommended providing a resource for dental students to start and/or maintain a food pantry at their dental school. This new resource was published in January and ASDA is continuing to work on establishing partnerships with Amazon Fresh and Uber Eats.

Because food insecurity is a growing concern among dental students, the Council on Membership is also recommending the following policy as part of their work in this area.

**RESOLUTION**

**Resolved,** that ASDA recognizes that food insecurity is a growing concern among dental students and encourages members and ASDA chapters to work with local constituents and other stakeholders to institute local programs to address this issue.
