### **Resolution Presentation**

Chiaravalli made changes to the Disciplinary Subcommittee as Hale and Weidig will no longer be on the Board. Brewer was made the public chairperson and Morgan was added as a professional member.

### **Department Update**

Ditschman stated that a Board Member training will be held on July 30, 2020 and all are welcome. She stated that the training is now split into two sessions: One session will cover the Occupational Code and Deaf Persons' Interpreters Act professions. The other session will cover the Public Health Code professions.

Ditschman stated that the Executive Order that allowed hours spent working for COVID-19 pandemic hours during the COVID-19 crisis to count toward continuing education was rescinded on June 3, 2020. Only hours earned before that time will be applied for renewal.

Ditschman stated that the state of emergency currently ends on June 19, 2020. Continuing education is waived through that date for license renewals. This also applies to the CPR requirement.

Ditschman stated that HB5446 will add two new specialties in dentistry: oral maxiofacial ~~surgery~~ *radiology* and dental anesthesiologist.

Inman asked if the Department has a date scheduled for the RDA examination. Poynter stated that he was not aware of one but would follow up with the Department.

## **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Maria Oleski made a statement regarding Guy Shampaigne's presentation. She asked that Michigan consider adopting the alternative non-patient examination.

Liane Racelis gave a statement regarding the temporary license and testing.
