Council business

Connecting with Chapter Leaders

- The council focused on connecting regularly with chapter and district community service leaders via a GroupMe group chat.
- The council hosted a webinar in September titled Community Service at your Chapter Webinar: Ideas and Resources for Community Service Chairs, to share information on the community service initiatives that will be happening throughout the year.

• Community Builder of the Year Award

• Dentistry in the Community Grant

- This year, the council was tasked with planning DEI Week in October 2024.
- The Council hosted a webinar, D&I in Dentistry. During this webinar, attendees heard from a panel of dentists who are fostering inclusion in their practices and community.

Service Month

- The council held ASDA's second annual Service Month in January 2025.
- o The theme was Growing in Service.

- The council hosted two Service Month webinars, Service Above Self Leading Through Community Service, with Dr. Mai-Ly Duong, and a clinical community service webinar with Drs. Martha Forero, James Morrish, and Elbert Tom.
