| 16             | Background: At the 2020 House of Delegates, Resolution 303S1-2020 was referred to the 2020-       |
| 17             | 21 Council on Professional Issues to study the implications of banning vaping products and        |
| 18             | alternatives at national meetings, and determine if this policy needs to be revised to be in      |
| 19             | alignment with ASDA's E-4 Sensitivity to Diversity policy. The 2020-21 Council on Professional    |
| 20             | Issues was tasked with reporting back at the 2021 House of Delegates meeting.                     |

| 22             | After reviewing the E-4 policy, the council determined that since ASDA does not host any          |
| 23             | religious or cultural ceremonies, the proposed amendment is not in conflict. Additionally, ASDA   |
| 24             | already has the I-4 policy discouraging the use of tobacco, e-cigarettes, vaping products and     |
| 25             | alternatives. The council agreed ASDA should not have policies in conflict with one another that  |
| 26             | would discourage the use generally, but not during national meetings.                             |

| 28             | The council discussed the question of where and under what time frame the phrase "national        |
| 29             | meetings" covers, for the possibility of a member engaging in a religious or cultural experience  |
| 30             | that requires the use of tobacco, e-cigarettes, vaping products or alternatives. It was therefore |
| 31             | determined the word "recreational" would be added to the policy to solidify these items are       |
| 32             | prohibited under recreational use, but not necessarily under religious or cultural use at its     |
| 33             | national meetings.  |
