Animal studies provide the most relevant data when making a comparison to human models, since mouse models are genetically the most similar to humans, and the most widely accepted model organism for research. However, great precaution should be taken when selecting an animal model for research, designing a study with the utmost care and humane way to treat the animals, and ultimately deciding if an in vivo (live animal) model is absolutely necessary for research, versus in vitro (cell culture). Study models should be carefully reviewed as to not cause them undue harm or unnecessary suffering, and appropriate training should be taken place for researchers involved in the study. Studies involving animal models must go under review by several institutional bodies, including but not limited to the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC), and the Institutional Review Board (IRB) of that university or research facility. For this reason, ASDA should support the use of animals in scientific research, testing, and education, in a manner compliant with the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) as well as the Institutional Review Board (IRB). Therefore, be it **RESOLUTION**

The American Student Dental Association supports the use of animals in scientific research, testing, and education in a responsible-manner compliant with the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee.
