The board believes that as the strategic governing body of the association, all student leaders of the Board of Trustees should be elected. The Editorial Board is a standing committee of the association, therefore it's not appropriate or necessary for the operations of the board to have the chair (Editor-in-Chief) of a standing committee sit on the board. By removing the Editor-in-Chief from the board, the Editor-in-Chief will be better able to focus on its duties to the editorial board. The Editor-in-Chief will still have the opportunity to report to the Board at the Spring and Fall Council Meetings or at any time by board invitation.
