To 17 allow for candidates who are nominated from the floor, the 2020-21 Governance Committee proposes the definition of an 'unofficial candidate.' This additional language will serve as 18 19 clarification. 20 21 22 RESOLUTION 23 24 Resolved, that the Bylaws, Article VII Elections, Section 1. Candidacy, B. Unofficial Candidate be 25 amended as follows: 26 27 ARTICLE VII **ELECTIONS** 28 29 Section 1. **Candidacy** 30 31 A. Official Candidate 32 33 An eligible member wishing to be an official candidate for the Executive Committee 34 or district trustee must submit an application and required materials to the 35 executive director by the established deadline. Official Executive Committee 36 candidates have their applications materials posted on the ASDA website at least 37 three weeks prior to the Annual Session, receive formal district caucusing privileges 38 and have their name printed on ballots. 39 **B.** Unofficial Candidate Nominations from the Floor 40 41 42 An eligible member who does not meet the criteria of an official candidate may run as an 'unofficial candidate.' Unofficial candidates Nominees from the floor 43 44 must submit application materials electronically to the Executive Director prior to 45 the first meeting of the House of Delegates. These materials will be posted online by the end of the day. **Unofficial candidates** Nominees from the floor will be placed on 46

47	the ballot. Nominees from the floor, but are not considered official candidates for
48	office and are not entitled to the caucusing privileges of official candidates.
49	Unofficial candidates Nominees from the floor are no longer eligible candidates
50	once they do not advance to a subsequent ballot. Write in candidates for the
51	Executive Committee are not permitted.

53	C. Write-In Candidates

55	Write-in candidates for the Executive Committee or speaker of the House of
56	Delegates are not permitted.
