President and Vice Presidents 29 30 The first ballot lists the names of all official candidates for president/vice presidents. 31 Should there only be three candidates running for president/vice presidents, all 32 candidates automatically advance to the second ballot. Each delegate votes for 33 three different candidates and only ballots with exactly three different candidates 34 selected are valid. The first ballot determines the president/vice presidents and the 35 three candidates receiving the most votes advance to the second ballot. In the case of a tie, more than three candidates will advance to a subsequent ballot containing 36 37 the remaining candidates' names. Balloting will continue until the president/vice 38 presidents are determined in the same manner as the first ballot.
